Class News

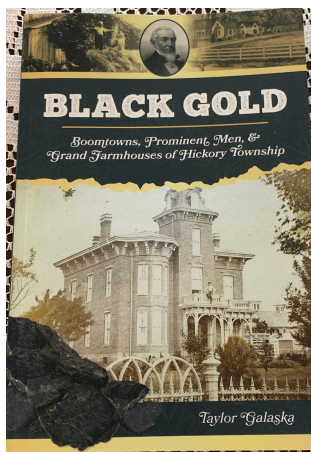
1. They've written a book about us! Well, not the Class of '71 per se, however the history of Hickory Township.

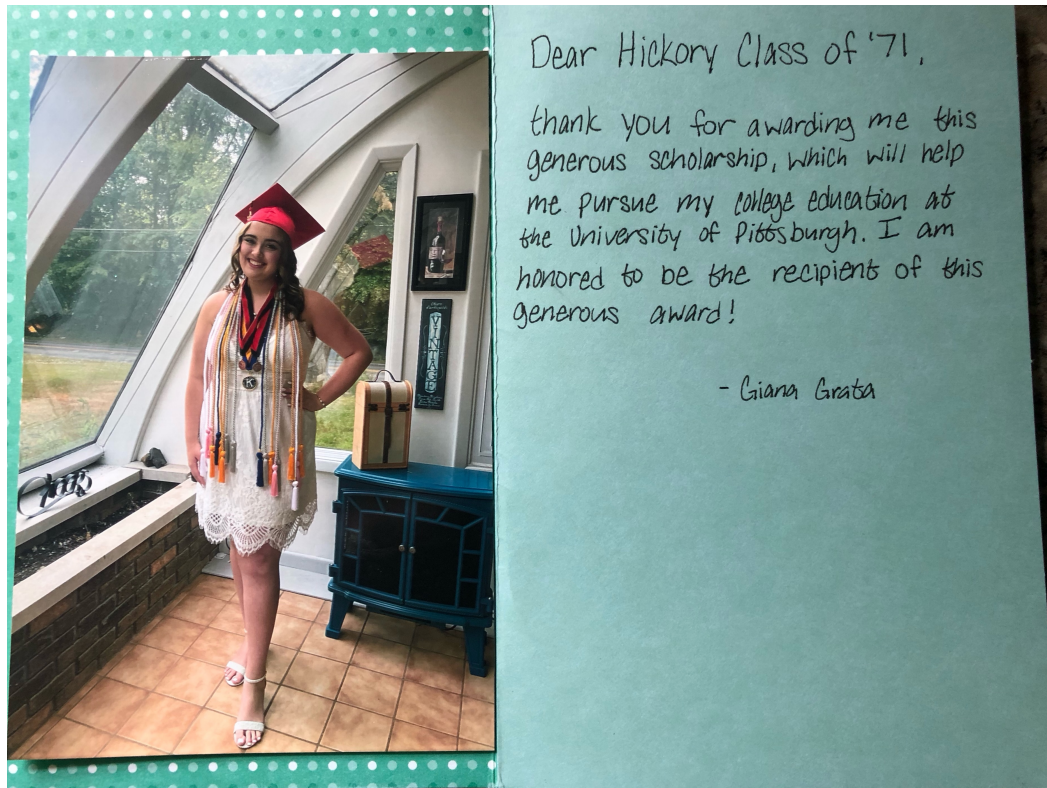
